REGULATION 72 (1)

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by Regulation 72 (1) of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, issued a General Authority, a copy of which is appended, to cover the driving of motor vehicles by members of H.M. Forces when on duty, subject to the issue by the Highway Board of certificates in the form set out in the Schedule to the General Authority.

REGULATION 72 (1)

GENERAL AUTHORITY.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 72 (1) of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and of all other powers me in that behalf enabling DO hereby give my general authority under the said paragraph of the said Regulation in the case of the driving of all vehicles by members of His Majesty's Forces when on duty only, provided that any such member of His Majesty's Forces shall have obtained and have in his possession a certificate issued by the Highway Board in the terms set forth in the Schedule hereto.
