FERTILISERS.

The Control of Fertilisers (No. 1) Order, 1939,

Direction No. 4.

The Lieutenant-Governor wishes to bring to the attention of those concerned with the importation into the Isle of Man and the sale of fertilisers, the Control of Fertilisers (No. 1) Order, 1939, Direction No. 4, dated 28th June, 1940 (revoking Direction No. 3.), which has been made by the Minister of Supply, specifying the amounts by which the basic price of fertilisers as fixed by the Control of Fertilisers (Nos. 1 & 2) Orders, 1939, referred to in Government Circular No. 2145, delivered during the months of July and August, 1940, shall be reduced, and the amounts by which the basic prices so reduced may be increased in respect of the different kinds of fertiliser delivered during the months of July, August and September, 1940.
