



The Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939.

The Fat Cattle (Prohibition of Sale and Slaughter) (No. 3) Order, 1940.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, made an Order dated the 18th July, 1940, (a copy of which is appended) prohibiting the sale and slaughter of Fat Cattle during the period commencing on the 19th July and ending on the 27th July, 1940.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

THE FAT CATTLE (PROHIBITION OF SALE AND SLAUGHTER) (No. 3) ORDER, 1940.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, and all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Fat Cattle (Regulation of Sale) Order, 1939, or any Order amending such Order:—
 - (i) no person shall, during the period commencing on the 19th day of July and ending on the 27th day of July, 1940, sell or agree to sell, or offer or expose for sale, or buy or agree to buy any bovine animal, which is sold as fat and ready for slaughter; and
 - (ii) no person shall slaughter or agree to slaughter any bovine animal during the aforesaid period except with the written authority of the Government Secretary or other duly authorised officer.
2. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Fat Cattle (Prohibition of Sale and Slaughter) (No. 3) Order, 1940."
