**THE REGULATION OF PAYMENTS (GENERAL EXEMPTIONS)
(ISLE OF MAN) ORDER, 1940.**

DATED JULY 17, 1940.

Whereas by paragraph (1) of Regulation three C of the Defence (Finance) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, restrictions are placed on payments, transfers and other transactions to or in favour of persons resident outside the sterling area, but those restrictions are subject to any exemptions which may be granted by order of the Treasury:

Now, therefore, the Treasury in pursuance of their powers under the said Regulation three C and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Payments (General Exemptions) (Isle of Man) Order, 1940.
2. There are hereby exempted from the operation of paragraph (1) of the said Regulation three C—
 - (a) any payment, transfer or other transaction made or carried out by a person resident outside the sterling area, being a payment or transfer to, or other transaction in favour of, a person resident neither in the sterling area nor in any of the territories specified in the Schedule to this Order; and
 - (b) anything done for the purpose of giving effect to any payment, transfer or transaction exempted from the operation of the said paragraph (1) by sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph.
3. This Order shall come into force on the eighteenth day of July, 1940.
