THE FRESH FRUIT & VEGETABLES (RECORD OF DEALINGS) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above styled Order, a copy of which is appended.

This Order revokes the Fresh Fruit and Vegetables (Record of Dealings) Order, 1949, under the provisions of which wholesalers of fruit and vegetables were subject to certain restrictions.

(Four maximum price Orders relating to fruit have been simultaneously amended by separate Orders so as to provide for the keeping of records of sales of fruit otherwise than by retail, which provision was formerly made by the revoked Order.

The four Orders are:—

The Citrus Fruit (Maximum Prices) Order, 1944, as amended;

The Bananas Order, 1948;

The Imported Apples (Maximum Retail Prices) (No. 3) Order, 1948, as amended; and

The Home-Grown Apples (Maximum Prices) Order, 1949.

These are the only maximum-price Orders relating to Fresh Fruit and Vegetables—other than those relating to potatoes and carrots, to which the revoked Order did not apply—in operation at the date of coming into operation of the present Order).

The Order comes into force on the 15th January, 1950.

Copies of the Order may be obtained at Government Office, or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall, and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

**THE FRESH FRUIT & VEGETABLES (RECORD
OF DEALINGS) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55, 55AA and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order :—

1. The Fresh Fruit and Vegetables (Record of Dealings) Order, 1949, is hereby revoked, but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.

2. This Order may be cited as the Fresh Fruit and Vegetables (Record of Dealings) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of January, 1950.
