THE DISCOUNT ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as amended by the Supplies and Services (Intended Purpose) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, do hereby make the following Order :-

1. The Discount (Maximum Retail Prices) Order, 1943, as amended, shall be further amended by substituting in Article 1 thereof for the definition of "The Alliance" the following definition :-

" 'The Alliance' means, until the 9th day of December, 1949, The Cake and Discount Manufacturers' War Time Alliance Limited, and thereafter The Cake and Discount Alliance Limited".

2. This Order may be cited as The Discount Order, 1950; and shall come into operation on the 29th day of January, 1950.
