THE FOODS AND SOAP (REGULATION OF EXPORTATION) ORDER, 1948

GENERAL LICENCE No. 4

Pursuant to Article 1 of the Foods and Soap (Regulation of Exportation) Order, 1948, the Lieutenant Governor hereby directs that as from the 26th February, 1950, the following goods may be freely exported from the Isle of Man notwithstanding the provisions of the said Foods and Soap (Regulation of Exportation) Order, 1948, as amended (a):—

- (i) Canned Pork.
- (ii) Imported quick frozen pre-cooked meat meals.
- (iii) Vienna Sausages.
- (iv) Dried Plums or Prunes.
- (v) All Stoned Dates.
