**THE CONTROL OF PAPER (MAGAZINES) (ECONOMY)
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby order as follows:—

1. The Control of Paper (Magazines) (Economy) Order, 1949 (a), which controls the quantity of paper which may be used in the production of magazines, periodicals and news bulletins, is hereby revoked.
2. This Order may be cited as the Control of Paper (Magazines) (Economy) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of March, 1950.
