ISLE OF MAN GOVERNMENT SERVICE— STARTING PAY ON APPOINTMENT.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has approved that on the appointment of an officer to any of the three grades mentioned below, the officer should enter the Scale laid down for the grade at the point appropriate to the age of the officer up to a maximum age of 25.

Officers appointed below the age of 25 will take their birthdays as their incremental dates.

Officers whose age is 25 or over on date of appointment will take the date of their appointment as their incremental dates.

With regard to officers at present in the grades of Assistant Female Clerical Officers and Shorthand Typists His Excellency has decided that:—

- (1) Officers below the age of 25 years on appointment should be raised to the point appropriate to their age with effect as from 1st March, 1950.
- (2) Officers whose age was 25 years or above on appointment should be regarded as having entered the scale on their appointment at the age of 25 years and that their salaries should be raised to the point above the point of 25 years of age point which the number of years of service in the grade prior to the 1st March, 1950, would qualify them, with effect as from the 1st March, 1950, provided that no officer shall suffer any reduction of salary.

This Circular has been agreed with the Staff Side of the Whitley Council for the Isle of Man Public Service.
