THE IMPORTED EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES)  
ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order revoking and re-enacting with amendments The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) Order, 1945.

This Order fixes the maximum retail prices of eggs imported into the Isle of Man, from the Republic of Ireland, as follows:—

“Eggs” means the eggs in shell of domestic fowls or domestic ducks.

These prices do not apply to eggs served as a meal or part of a meal.

The Order comes into force on the 12th day of April, 1950.

Copies of the Order may be obtained at Government Office, or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

THE IMPORTED EGGS (MAXIMUM PRICES)  
ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO HEREBY make the following Order:—

1. In this Order:—

- (1) "Buy" includes offer or agree to buy, and "sell" includes offer or agree to sell or expose for sale.
- (2) "Catering Establishment" means a catering establishment licensed or deemed to be licensed as such under the Food Control Committees (Registration of Establishments) Order, 1941, as amended.
- (3) "Eggs" means the eggs in shell of domestic fowls or domestic ducks.
- (4) "Imported eggs" means eggs imported into the Isle of Man.
- (5) "Sale by retail" means any sale to a person buying for the purpose of resale but shall not include a sale to a caterer for the purpose of a catering business carried on by him, and the expressions "selling by retail" and "retailer" shall be construed accordingly.

2. No person shall buy or sell any imported eggs by retail at a price exceeding the appropriate maximum price specified in the schedule to this Order.

3. No person shall in connection with the sale or disposition or proposed sale or disposition of any imported eggs enter or offer to enter into any artificial transaction or make or demand any unreasonable charge.

4. The provisions of this Order shall not apply to cooked eggs served as a meal or part of a meal.

5. (1) The provisions of this Order are subject to any directions which may at any time be given by or on behalf of the Governor, and to any licence or authorisation which may be granted by or on behalf of the Governor under this Order.

(2) Every person holding a licence or authorisation granted under this Order shall comply with every condition imposed by such licence or authorisation.

6. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as amended.

7. The Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) Order, 1945, is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.

8. (1) This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of April, 1950.

(2) This Order may be cited as the "Imported Eggs (Maximum Prices) Order, 1950."
