SUPPLIES AND SERVICES.

THE FOOD (POINTS RATIONING) (No. 2) ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order, a copy of which is appended, further amending The Food (Points Rationing) (No. 5) Order, 1949.

This amending Order:—

- (a) reduces from 18 to 16 per four weeks the number of points available to the holder of a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4 or a Child's Ration Book R.B.2. The value of each points coupon in a Form R.B.12 or a Duty Ration Card R.B.8R is reduced from  $4\frac{1}{2}$  to 4 points and in a Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B.8A from 3 to 2 points. The value of other points coupons remains unchanged;
- (b) frees all meat and meat products, canned beans, all varieties of canned milk and shredded suet from the provisions of the Order;
- (c) reduces the points values of table jellies.

Copies of the Order may be obtained at Government Office or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

SUPPLIES AND SERVICES.

THE FOOD (POINTS RATIONING) (No. 2) ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Food (Points Rationing) (No. 5) Order, 1949, as amended, shall be further amended as follows :—

- (a) by deleting from paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof the definition of seaman's condensed milk coupon;
- (b) by deleting from the definition of "Authorised quantity" in paragraph (1) of Article 1 thereof and from Article 4 thereof and from paragraph (1) of Article 5 thereof the words "other than a seaman's condensed milk coupon" wherever they appear;
- (c) by deleting paragraph (2) of Article 5 thereof;
- (d) by substituting for the First Schedule thereto the Schedule to this Order;
- (e) by deleting from the Second Schedule thereto Parts I, IV, V and XV thereof relating to meat and meat products, canned vegetables, canned condensed milk and shredded suet;
- (f) by substituting in column 3 of Part XVI of the said Second Schedule, relating to table jellies, for the points values "6," "6," "6," "180" and "27 per pound" the points values "4," "4," "4," "120" and "18 per pound" respectively;
- (g) by deleting the Third Schedule thereto.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of April, 1950, and may be cited as The Food (Points Rationing) (No. 2) Order, 1950.
