**The Agricultural Land (Cultivation)
Directions (Revocation) Order, 1950.**

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order, revoking the Agricultural Land (Cultivation) Directions, 1940 (a), which allowed a tenant of agricultural land, with the consent of the Isle of Man Board of Agriculture and Fisheries and subject to conditions imposed by the Board, to break up out of lea and bring into cropping rotation land which had been in lea for not less than one year, notwithstanding any restriction to the contrary.

**THE AGRICULTURAL LAND ((CULTIVATION)
DIRECTIONS (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 62 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Agricultural Land (Cultivation) Directions, 1940, are hereby revoked, but such revocation shall not affect anything done or omitted to be done under such Directions.

2. This Order may be cited as the Agricultural Land (Cultivation) Directions (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
