THE FARM MACHINERY (CONTROL OF MANUFACTURE AND
SUPPLY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order revoking the Farm Machinery (Control of Manufacture and Supply) Order, 1943 (a) which controlled the production and distribution of agricultural machinery in the Isle of Man.

Manufacturers and retailers of farm machinery no longer need obtain licences to trade.

THE FARM MACHINERY (CONTROL OF MANUFACTURE AND
SUPPLY) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Farm Machinery (Control of Manufacture and Supply) Order, 1943, is hereby revoked.
2. This Order may be cited as the Farm Machinery (Control of Manufacture and Supply) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
