### THE CONTROL OF FUEL (MISCELLANEOUS ORDERS) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950

---

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order revoking the following Orders :—

The Regulation of the Use of Fuel in Glasshouses, Order, 1942 ;

The Coal (Control of Importation) Order, 1939 ; and

The Coke Control Order, 1939.

The effect of the Order is to remove all restrictions on the use of fuel in glasshouses, to allow of the importation of coal without licence, and to remove all restrictions on the sale of coke.

THE CONTROL OF FUEL (MISCELLANEOUS ORDERS)  
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order :—

- 1.—The Orders set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.
- 2.—This Order may be cited as the Control of Fuel (Miscellaneous Orders) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
