# THE MOTOR FUEL (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950

This Order made by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor amends the Motor Fuel (Control) Order, 1948, by

- (a) increasing the coupon-free allowance to dealers for working losses, in the case of motor spirit from 1 per cent. to 1½ per cent.;
- (b) increasing the value of the unit, for every standard ration coupon relating to any month after May, 1950, to one gallon;
- (c) enabling holders of standard ration coupons for the rationing period June-November in any year to obtain motor fuel against them before the beginning of the rationing period.

# THE MOTOR FUEL (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1950

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948. DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Motor Fuel (Control) Order, 1948, as amended, shall have effect subject to the modifications specified in this Order.

2. In the proviso to sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (1) of Article 1 (which relates to wholesale supplies of motor fuel to dealers), there shall be substituted for the words "of one per centum" the words "in the case of heavy oil (as defined in Article 19), of one per centum, or, in any other case, of one and one-half per centum."

3. In Article 10 (which relates to the value of units), the following sub-paragraph shall be substituted for sub-paragraph (a):—

"(a) a standard ration coupon relating to the month of May, 1950, or any earlier month, one-half of a gallon and one-quarter of a gallon respectively;"

4. In paragraph (1) of Article 11 (which relates to the supply of motor fuel against standard ration coupons)—

(a) in sub-paragraph (b), the word "and" shall be deleted;

(b) in sub-paragraph (c), there shall be added at the end the word "and";

(c) the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted after the said sub-paragraph (c):—

"(d) in the case of a coupon relating to any month in the rationing period beginning on the first day of June in any year, the period (if any) between the issue thereof and the said first day of June."

5. This Order shall come into operation on the eighth day of May, 1950, and may be cited as the Motor Fuel (Control) (Amendment) Order, 1950.
