

## THE MEAT RATIONING ORDER, 1942.

### INCREASE IN THE MEAT RATION.

In pursuance of Article 4 of the above mentioned Order His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made a Direction dated the 18th May, 1950, increasing the amount of meat which a Registered Butcher may supply to a registered customer or to a person holding a ration document, with effect from the 22nd May, 1950.

As from such date, until further notice, the meat ration shall not exceed the undermentioned amounts :—

1. Amount against the appropriate coupons relating to each week in :—

General Ration Book R.B. 1	}	2s. 4d. maximum retail price (1s. 2d. maximum retail price for each coupon)
Junior Ration Book R.B. 4		
Form R.B. 12		
Ration Book R.B. I (N.A.A.)		
  
2. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a :—

Child's Ration Book R.B.2	}	1s. 2d. maximum retail price.
Ration Book R.B.7		
Leave or Duty Ration Card R.B. 8A		
  
3. Amount against each appropriate coupon in a weekly Seamen's Ration Book R.B.6 :—
  - (a) being a coupon through which a hole has been punched ... .. 2s. 10d. maximum retail price.
  - (b) not being a coupon through which a hole has been punched 5s. 8d. maximum retail price.
