# **The Dry Batteries & Electric Torches (Prices) (Revocation) Order, 1950.**

The maximum prices of dry batteries are now controlled by Orders made under the Goods and Services (Price Control) Acts, 1939 and 1941. Electric Torches are not controlled.

## **THE DRY BATTERIES AND ELECTRIC TORCHES (PRICES) (REVOCATION) ORDER, 1950.**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The following Orders are hereby revoked:—

(1) The Dry Batteries (Prices) Order, 1940.

(2) The Electric Torches, &c. (Maximum Prices) Order, 1940.

2. This Order may be cited as the Dry Batteries and Electric Torches (Prices) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
