THE BEER (MAXIMUM PRICES) (REVOCATION)
ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, do hereby order as follows:—

1. The Beer (Maximum Prices) Order, 1949, is hereby revoked.

2. This Order may be cited as the Beer (Maximum Prices) (Revocation) Order, 1950, and shall come into force on the date hereof.
