THE PRICES OF GOODS (PRICE-REGULATED GOODS) (No. 5) ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order, a copy of which is appended, which removes from the list of price regulated goods contained in the Schedule to the Prices of Goods (Price-Regulated Goods) (No. 3) Order, 1949, the following goods:—

1. Articles of footwear and legwear.
2. Coir and sisal mats and matting.
3. Electric dry batteries.

The Order comes into force on the 12th day of June, 1950.

THE PRICES OF GOODS (PRICE-REGULATED GOODS) (No. 5) ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Sections 2 and 19 of the Prices of Goods Act, 1939, as extended to the Isle of Man by the Goods and Services (Price Control) (Isle of Man) Order, 1943, and of all other powers in that behalf me enabling, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:

1. The Prices of Goods (Price-Regulated Goods) (No. 3) Order, 1949, as amended, shall have effect subject to the following amendments to the Schedule thereto:—

(i) item 5 shall be omitted;

(ii) for item 7 there shall be substituted the following item:—

“7. Carpets, rugs, mats and other floor coverings (other than linoleum, printed felt base and articles made wholly or mainly of coir or sisal or a mixture of coir and sisal).”;

(iii) item 9 shall be omitted.

2. This Order may be cited as “The Prices of Goods (Price-Regulated Goods) (No. 5) Order, 1950,” and shall come into operation on the 12th day of June, 1950.
