ADDITIONAL IMPORT DUTIES (No. 1) (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER, 1950

CUSTOMS.

Additional Import Duties (No. 1) (Isle of Man) Order, 1950.

WHEREAS under the Import Duties (Consolidation) (Isle of Man) Order, 1950, (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order") it was ordered that the provisions of the Import Duties (Consolidation) Order, 1950, made by the Treasury (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Treasury Order") should apply to the importation into the Isle of Man of the classes and descriptions of goods referred to therein as they apply to the importation of such goods into the United Kingdom.

AND WHEREAS the principal Treasury Order has been amended by Treasury Order, No. 1 of the 25th May, 1950.

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said Lieutenant Governor by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 2 of the Isle of Man (Customs) (No. 2) Act, 1932, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf hereby make the following Order:—

- (1) As from the date of the making of this Order, references in the principal Order to the principal Treasury Order shall be construed as references to that Order as amended by the said Treasury Order No. 1 of the 25th May, 1950.
- (2) This Order may be cited as the Additional Import Duties (No. 1) (Isle of Man) Order, 1950.
