THE GOODS AND SERVICES (PRICE CONTROL) (No. 90)
ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order under the Goods and Services (Price Control) Act, 1941, as extended to the Isle of Man by the Goods and Services (Price Control) (Isle of Man) Order, 1943, providing that the maximum prices and/or charges to be charged in the Isle of Man for

Utility Bedding
Carpets
Imported Carpets

shall be the same as those fixed by Orders made by the Board of Trade, and terminating the application in the Isle of Man of the Board of Trade Order controlling the price of

Electric Torch Dry Batteries

which now cease to be price-controlled.

One Order made by His Excellency (No. 43) has been revoked, and others are amended to correspond with revocations and amendments of Board of Trade Orders relating to these goods.

The Order comes into force on the 30th day of June, 1950.

The new Board of Trade Orders concerned are specified in the First Schedule to the Order, a copy of which is appended.

The Utility Bedding (Maximum Prices) (No. 2) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 877 (price 2d.) supersedes the Utility Bedding (Maximum Prices) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 550. Wholesalers' and retailers' maximum prices are no longer subject to overriding cash maximum ("ceiling") prices and are now to be computed solely by adding the appropriate margin to the price paid.

The Carpets (Maximum Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 916 (price 3d.) amends S.I. 1950 No. 97, by substituting for the First Schedule a new Schedule containing increased manufacturers' and wholesalers' maximum prices and retailer's overriding maximum prices for price control group carpets. Maximum prices are also provided for new descriptions of Wilton carpets and rugs.

The Imported Carpets (Maximum Prices) (No. 3) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 917 (price 2d.) supersedes the Imported Carpets (Maximum Prices) (No. 2) Order, 1950.

1. It provides increased overriding maximum prices of 63s. od. per square yard for imported seamless squares and broadloom carpets and 62s. 1d. per square yard for other types of imported carpets.
2. The importer's and wholesaler's maximum price for carpets manufactured in India or Pakistan is increased to 46s. 1d. per square yard.

3. The definition of "imported carpets" has been amended so as to exclude from the Order price control group carpets to which the price control group label is not attached.

The Orders specified in the First Schedule to the Order may be seen or purchased at the Office of the Secretary of the Price Regulation Committee, 1, Hope Street, Douglas, or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to prosecution.

**THE GOODS AND SERVICES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (No. 90)
ORDER, 1950.**

WHEREAS the Board of Trade under the powers vested in them under the Goods and Services (Price Control) Act, 1941, have from time to time made Orders fixing the maximum prices and/or charges to be charged in the course of the businesses comprising the sale of goods and/or the performing of services in relation thereto, and requiring the keeping of records and the display of notices in respect of certain goods in the course of such businesses, and it is desirable that the prices and charges of such goods and services so fixed should be the maximum prices and charges to be charged and that such records should be kept and such notices displayed in respect of such businesses in the Isle of Man.

NOW I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Sections 1, 13 and 18 of the Goods and Services (Price Control) Act, 1941, as extended to the Isle of Man by the Goods and Services (Price Control) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1943, and all other powers and authorities me in this behalf enabling, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:—

1. The maximum prices and charges to be charged, the records to be kept, and the notices to be displayed in the course of the businesses dealt with by the Orders of the Board of Trade set out in the First Schedule hereto, and in relation to the goods referred to in such Orders, ascertained in the manner specified in such Orders (the Orders being read together with any repeals, amendments or variations), shall be the maximum prices and charges which may be charged, the records which shall be kept, and the notices which shall be displayed in respect of such businesses and in relation to such goods in this Island.

2. The Orders set out in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto shall have effect subject to the omission from the respective Schedule thereto of the Orders of the Board of Trade set out in the second column of the Second Schedule hereto.

3. The Order set out in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby revoked.

4. This Order may be cited as "The Goods and Services (Maximum Prices) (No. 90) Order, 1950," and shall come into force on the 30th day of June, 1950.
