SUPPLIES AND SERVICES.

The Bacon (Rationing) (No. 4) Order, 1950

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order, a copy of which is appended, amending the Bacon (Rationing) (No. 3) Order, 1950, (a).

This amending Order, as from the 18th June, 1950.

(a) increases the amount of the bacon ration which may be obtained against appropriate coupons in Ration Books R.B.1, R.B.2 and R.B.4 and a Form R.B.12 from 4 ozs. to 5 ozs. per week. Appropriate coupons in these ration documents valid for use during the week beginning 11th June, 1950, and the following week, but not used in the week beginning 11th June, 1950, are valid if used in the week beginning 18th June, 1950, for 4 ozs. only:

(b) deletes certain provisions relating to establishments.

Copies of the Order may be obtained at Government Office or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

SUPPLIES AND SERVICES.

THE BACON (RATIONING) (No. 4) ORDER, 1950.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Bacon (Rationing) (No. 3) Order, 1950, shall be amended as follows:—

(a) by substituting in the 2nd Column of the Schedule thereto (which specifies the amount of the bacon ration) for the amount "4 oz." in relation to each appropriate coupon in a General Ration Book R.B.1, a Junior Ration Book R.B.4, a Childs' Ration Book R.B.2 and a Form R.B.12 the amount "5 oz.";

(b) by deleting Article 6 thereof.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-paragraph (a) of Article 1 of this Order, the maximum amount of bacon which may be obtained or supplied against an appropriate coupon for bacon in any of the ration documents mentioned in the said sub-paragraph relating to the week beginning 11th June, 1950, and valid for use during the said week and the following week, but not used during the said week beginning 11th June, 1950, shall be 4 oz. net.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of June, 1950, and may be cited as The Bacon (Rationing) (No. 4) Order, 1950.
