THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (No. 3) ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made the above-styled Order, a copy of which is appended, amending the Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (No. 2) Order, 1950 (a).

This amending Order substitutes in the Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (No. 2) Order, 1950, a revised definition of cheese, listing those varieties which are subject to rationing.

The Order comes into force on the 2nd July, 1950.

Copies of the Order may be obtained at Government Office or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

**THE FATS, CHEESE AND TEA (RATIONING) (No. 3)
ORDER, 1950.**

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (No. 2) Order, 1950 shall be amended by substituting for the definition of cheese in Article 1 thereof the following definition:—

“ ‘Cheese’ means—

- (a) any cheese of the following varieties, whether home produced or imported, namely, Cheddar, Cheshire, Lancashire, Derbyshire, Leicestershire, White Wensleydale or Dunlop;
- (b) any processed cheese, that is to say cheese which after manufacture has been heated and to which an emulsifying agent has been added, of the varieties set out in subparagraph (a) of this definition.”

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July, 1950, and may be cited as the Fats, Cheese and Tea (Rationing) (No. 3) Order, 1950.
