THE FOOD (RETAIL PRICES) (No. 4) ORDER, 1950

HIS EXCELLENCY THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR has made the above-styled Order, a copy of which is appended, further amending The Food (Retail Prices) Consolidation Order, 1949 (a).

This amending Order releases from price control all cheese except varieties that are needed for the ration.

The Order comes into force on the 2nd July, 1950.

Copies of the Order may be obtained at Government Office, or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall, and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

THE FOOD (RETAIL PRICES) (No. 4) ORDER, 1950

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Food (Retail Prices) Consolidation Order, 1949, shall be further amended as follows:—

(a) by substituting for the definition of cheese in Article I thereof the following definition—

“Cheese” means—

- (i) any cheese of the following varieties, whether home produced or imported—Cheddar, Cheshire, Lancashire, Derbyshire, Leicestershire, White Wensleydale and Dunlop;
- (ii) any processed cheese, that is to say cheese which after manufacture has been heated and to which an emulsifying agent has been added, including imported pre-packed processed cheese of any of the varieties set out in paragraph (i) of this definition, but excluding any other imported pre-packed processed cheese.

(b) by substituting for the Schedule of Foods and Prices thereto the Schedule of Foods and Prices to this Order.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of July, 1950, and may be cited as The Food (Retail Prices) (No. 4) Order, 1950.
