SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)

THE MEAT (RETAIL PRICES) ORDER, 1950

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as amended, made the above-styled Order dated the 8th July, 1950, (a copy of which is appended), revising as from the 17th July, 1950, the maximum prices for sale by retail of beef.

A meat retailer must exhibit clearly and in a conspicuous position inside his premises a list of the descriptions of meat offered for sale and the maximum prices thereof, and must clearly mark the different grades of meat offered for sale.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)

THE MEAT (RETAIL PRICES) ORDER, 1950

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55, 55AA and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO HEREBY Order as follows:—

1. There shall be substituted for the Schedule to the Meat (Retail Prices) Order, (No. 1), 1942, as amended, the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Meat (Retail Prices) Order, 1949, is hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.
3. The Act for shortening the language used in Acts of Tynwald passed in the year 1865 applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Tynwald.
4. This Order may be cited as "The Meat (Retail Prices) Order, 1950," and shall come into operation on the 17th day of July, 1950.
