THE GOODS AND SERVICES (PRICE CONTROL) (No. 91)  
ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has made an Order under the Goods and Services (Price Control) Act, 1941, as extended to the Isle of Man by the Goods and Services (Price Control) (Isle of Man) Order, 1943, providing that the maximum prices and/or charges to be charged in the Isle of Man for

Imported Carpets  
Carpets  
Utility Apparel  
Women's and Maids' Nylon Hose  
Utility Handkerchiefs  
Utility Quilts  
General Hollow-ware  
Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles

shall be the same as those fixed by Orders made by the Board of Trade.

One Order made by His Excellency (No. 84) has been revoked, and others are amended to correspond with the revocations and amendments of Board of Trade Orders relating to these goods.

The Order comes into force on the 31st day of July, 1950.

The new Board of Trade Orders concerned are specified in the First Schedule to the Order, a copy of which is appended

The imported Carpets (Maximum Prices) (No.3) (Amendment) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 989 (price 1d.) corrects a drafting error in the principal Order by substituting a definition of "purchase price" for "purchase tax".

The Carpets (Maximum Prices) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1,000 (price 2d.) amends the principal Order, as amended, by providing lower maximum and overriding maximum prices for certain of the price control group carpets described in the schedule to the Order. The Order also makes provision for rounding on a sale by retail.

The Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) Order, 1949 (Amendment No. 8) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1001 (price 3d.) consolidates the Orders amending the Utility Apparel (Maximum Prices and Charges) Order, 1949. It also substitutes Related Schedule No. 1J (price 9d.) for Related Schedule No. 1H and Supplements Nos. 1, 2 and 3 thereto and brings into force Supplement No 2 (price 2d.) to Related Schedule No. 4J. Related Schedule No. 1J contains wholesalers' and retailers' over-riding maximum prices for men's, youths' and boys' utility outerwear (other than knitted apparel and gloves); Related Schedule No. 4J contains wholesalers' and retailers' over-riding maximum prices for women's and maids' utility underwear and nightwear (other than knitted apparel).

The Womens' and Maids' Nylon Hose (Maximum Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1004 (price 1d.) amends the principal Order by increasing wholesalers' and retailers' over-riding maximum prices

for Fully Fashioned Nylon Hose made from 15 denier yarn and stamped with the words "15 denier".

The Utility Handkerchiefs (Maximum Prices) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1032 (price 2d.) amends the principal Order by providing increased wholesalers' and retailers' maximum prices for some utility cotton handkerchiefs. It also consolidates all the previous amendments to that Order that are still current.

The Utility Quilts (Maximum Prices) (No. 2) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1047 (price 3d.) supersedes the Utility Quilts (Maximum Prices) Order, 1950. The principal changes are as follows:—

- (i) the Order now fixes manufacturers' maximum prices for utility quilts; and
- (ii) wholesalers' and retailers' overriding maximum prices for utility quilts, other than wadded quilts, are increased.

The General Hollow-ware (Maximum Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1049 (price 1d.) amends the principal Order by increasing manufacturers' maximum prices for galvanised hollow-ware of types sold during the "basic period".

The Utility Cloth and Utility Household Textiles (Maximum Prices) (Amendment) (No. 9) Order, 1950, S.I. 1950 No. 1092 (price 2d.) amends the Principal Order, as amended, by—

- (a) adding to the goods to which that Order applies rayon dress and blouse cloth of the specification Nos. 1043/1, 1043/2, 1044/1 and 1044/2, and one spun rayon pyjama cloth of the specification No. 1400, which have recently been introduced into the utility range;
- (b) fixing increased maximum prices for six descriptions of utility cotton quilt cloths included in the Fourth Schedule to the Principal Order;
- (c) bringing into force Related Schedule No. 5J (price 4d.) (Utility Household Textiles) which replaces Related Schedule No. 5H and Supplement No. 1 thereto.
- (d) bringing into force Supplement No. 3 (price 3d.) to Related Schedule No. 6N (Utility Upholstery Cloth and Utility Curtain Cloth).

The Related Schedules set out the overriding maximum prices for the goods to which they relate.

The Orders set out in the First Schedule to the Order may be seen or purchased at the Office of the Secretary of the Price Regulation Committee, 1, Hope Street, Douglas, or may be seen at any Police Station on application to the Officer in Charge, at the Douglas Public Library, the Douglas Town Hall and the Offices of all the Town and Village Commissioners.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to prosecution.

**THE GOODS AND SERVICES (MAXIMUM PRICES) (No. 91)**

**ORDER, 1950.**

WHEREAS the Board of Trade under the powers vested in them under the Goods and Services (Price Control) Act, 1941, have from time to time made Orders fixing the maximum prices and/or charges to be charged in the course of the businesses comprising the sale of goods and/or the performing of services in relation thereto, and requiring the keeping of records and the display of notices in respect of certain goods in the course of such businesses, and it is desirable that the prices and charges of such goods and services so fixed should be the maximum prices and charges to be charged and that such records should be kept and such notices displayed in respect of such businesses in the Isle of Man.

NOW I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Sections 1, 2 and 18 of the Goods and Services (Price Control) Act, 1941, as extended to the Isle of Man by the Goods and Services (Price Control) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1943, and all other powers and authorities me in this behalf enabling, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:—

1. The maximum prices and charges to be charged, the records to be kept, and the notices to be displayed in the course of the businesses dealt with by the Orders of the Board of Trade set out in the First Schedule hereto, and in relation to the goods referred to in such Orders, ascertained in the manner specified in such Orders (the Orders being read together with any repeals, amendments or variations), shall be the maximum prices and charges which may be charged, the records which shall be kept, and the notices which shall be displayed in respect of such businesses and in relation to such goods in this Island.

2. The Orders set out in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto shall have effect subject to the omission from the respective Schedules thereto of the Orders of the Board of Trade set out in the second column of the Second Schedule hereto.

3. The Order set out in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby revoked.

4. This Order may be cited as "The Goods and Services (Maximum Prices) (No. 91) Order, 1950" and shall come into force on the 31st day of July, 1950.
