(TRANSITIONAL POWERS)

The Dredge Corn (Maximum Prices)
(No. 1) Order, 1950

His Excellency the Deputy Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as amended, made the above styled Order dated the 15th August, 1950, (a copy of which is appended) amending the Dredge Corn (Control and Prices) Order, 1949.

The amending Order fixes the following maximum prices for dredge corn (other than dredge corn for use as seed):—

On a sale by a Grower—

For delivery during the month of — 1950	Maximum Price per cwt. ex farm
	s. d.
August or September	21 3
October or November	21 5
December	21 7

The above mentioned prices do not include the cost or use of containers.

On a sale by an Approved Buyer—

For delivery during the month of — 1950	Maximum Price per cwt.
	s. d.
August or September	23 3
October or November	23 5
December	23 7

The above-mentioned maximum prices include the cost of delivery and hire charges for returnable sacks and no charge is allowed to be made in addition to such maximum prices in connection with the sale of any consignment of dredge corn.

Failure to comply with the terms of the Order renders a person liable to the penalties imposed by the Defence Regulations.

(TRANSITIONAL POWERS)

The Dredge Corn (Maximum Prices)
(No. 1) Order, 1950

I, the said Deputy Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55, 55AA and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO HEREBY Order as follows:—

1. For Article 4 of the Dredge Corn (Control and Prices) Order, 1949, there shall be substituted the following Article:—

“4(i) No grower shall sell or approved buyer shall buy dredge corn (other than dredge corn for use as seed) at a price exceeding the maximum price set out below for the month in which the sale takes place:—

For delivery during the month of — 1950	Maximum Price per cwt. ex farm
	s. d.
August or September	21 3
October or November	21 5
December	21 7

The aforesaid maximum prices shall not include the cost or use of containers.

(ii) No approved buyer shall sell to any person any dredge corn (other than dredge corn for use as seed) at a price exceeding the maximum price set out below for the month in which the sale takes place:—

For delivery during the month of — 1950	Maximum Price per cwt.

August or September	23 3
October or November	23 5
December	23 7

The aforesaid maximum prices shall include the cost of delivery and hire charges for returnable sacks and no charge shall be made in addition to such maximum prices in connection with the sale of any consignment of dredge corn.”

2. This Order may be cited as “The Dredge Corn (Maximum Prices) (No. 1) Order, 1950”.
