THE RABBITS (PROHIBITION OF EXPORT) (REVOCAION)  
ORDER, 1950.

His Excellency the Deputy Governor has, under the powers vested in him by the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man) 1939, as amended, made the abovestyled Order, dated the 25th August, 1950, (a copy of which is appended), revoking the Rabbits (Prohibition of Export) Order, 1944, and the Rabbits (Prohibition of Export) Amendment Order, 1944.

As from the 1st September, 1950, rabbits may be exported from the Isle of Man without restriction.

**THE RABBITS (PROHIBITION OF EXPORT) (REVOCAION)  
ORDER, 1950.**

I, the said Deputy Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Regulations 55, 55AA and 98 of the Defence (General) Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1946, as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) (Isle of Man) Order in Council, 1948, DO HEREBY Order as follows:—

1. The Rabbits (Prohibition of Export) Order, 1944, and the Rabbits (Prohibition of Export) Amendment Order, 1944, are hereby revoked but without prejudice to any proceedings in respect of any contravention thereof.

2. This Order may be cited as "The Rabbits (Prohibition of Export) (Revocation) Order, 1950" and shall come into operation on the 1st day of September, 1950.
