**THE IMPORT DUTIES (EXEMPTIONS) (No. 5) (ISLE OF MAN)  
ORDER, 1950.**

His Excellency the Deputy Governor has made an Order (a copy of which is appended) under section 1 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, and section 5 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1934, directing that the goods specified in such Order shall be added to the First Schedule to the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, and that the said Schedule as amended by the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) (Isle of Man) Order, 1936, and by subsequent Orders shall be further amended.

**THE IMPORT DUTIES (EXEMPTIONS) (No. 5) (ISLE OF MAN)  
ORDER, 1950.**

WHEREAS the Treasury has by Order (No. 5) dated the 1st day of August, 1950, made under Sections 1 and 19 of the Import Duties Act, 1932, Section 10 of the Finance Act, 1934, and Section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, ordered that the goods specified in such Order shall be added to the First Schedule to the Import Duties Act, 1932, and that the said First Schedule, as amended by the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) Order, 1955, and by subsequent Orders, shall be further amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said Deputy Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 1 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932, and Section 5 of the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1934, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, make the following Order:—

1. There shall be added to the First Schedule to the Isle of Man (Customs) Act, 1932 hereinafter referred to as "the Exemptions Schedule") the following goods, namely:—

Copper unwrought, whether refined or not, in billets.

2. Accordingly in that Schedule as amended by the Import Duties (Exemptions Consolidation) (Isle of Man) Order, 1936, and by subsequent Orders, and in the Second Annex to the said Order of 1936, as amended by subsequent Orders in paragraph (10) of Group VII, after the word "blocks", there shall be inserted the word "billets".

3. This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Exemptions) (Isle of Man) (No. 5) Order 1950.

4. This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of August, 1950.
