**Inheritance (Family Provision) Act, 1959  
(Appointed Day) Order, 1961.**

---

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 8 of the Inheritance (Family Provision) Act, 1959 that the Act shall take effect from such day as the Governor shall by Order appoint.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me as aforesaid DO hereby by Order appoint the fifth day of July, 1961, to be the appointed day for the purpose of the said Act.

This Order may be cited as the Inheritance (Family Provision) Act, 1959 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This Order fixes the appointed day on which the Inheritance (Family Provision) Act, 1959 comes into effect.
