**Representation of the People (Registration of
Electors) Act, 1961 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961**

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 54 of the Representation of the People (Registration of Electors) Act, 1961, that the Act shall take effect from such day as the Governor may by Order appoint, and different days may be appointed for the purposes of different provisions of the said Act and for the repeal of different enactments.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me as aforesaid DO hereby by Order appoint the twenty-first day of February, 1961, to be the appointed day for the purposes of all the provisions of the said Act.

This Order may be cited as the Representation of the People (Registration of Electors) Act, 1961 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961.
