NATIONAL INSURANCE

THE NATIONAL INSURANCE (ISLE OF MAN) ACT, 1961 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER, 1961.

WHEREAS by paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) of section one of the National Insurance (Isle of Man) Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Governor may, by Order, appoint the contribution week from which the provisions of the Act shall come into operation.

NOW THEREFORE, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by the Act and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, DO hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the National Insurance (Isle of Man) Act, 1961 (Commencement) Order, 1961.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1949, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Tynwald.
3. The contribution week appointed for the purposes of paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) of section one of the Act shall be the week commencing on the Third day of April, 1961.
