Inquests of Death Acts Remuneration of Deputy Coroner

WHEREAS under Section 2 of the Inquests of Death Act, 1951 as amended by Section 1 of the Inquests of Death Act, 1960 it is enacted that there shall be paid to any Deputy Coroner appointed under the provisions of the Act out of the General Revenue of this Isle such remuneration as may be determined from time to time by the Governor.

NOW, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the said section DO hereby order and determine that there shall be paid out of the General Revenue of this Isle—

- (1) in respect of each inquest undertaken by a Deputy Coroner appointed in accordance with the Inquests of Death Acts, 1852 to 1960 the following remuneration :—

For each day in which attendance at an inquest exceeds four hours,
the sum ofEight Guineas

For each day in which attendance at an inquest does not exceed
four hours, the sum ofFour Guineas

- (2) in respect of all duties undertaken by a Deputy Coroner appointed as aforesaid in pursuance of Section 8 of the Inquests of Death Act, 1934 in each case where an inquest is unnecessary, the sum of
.....One-and-One-Half-Guineas

- (3) in respect of the issue of any order in terms of the Civil Registration and Dissenters Marriages Act, 1933 (other than an Order in terms of subsection (1) of section three of the said Act) or of any regulations made under the said Act, the sum ofTen Shillings & Sixpence

- (4) in respect of any order required to be made under the Cremation Act, 1902 (being an Act of the Imperial Parliament) or of any regulations made thereunder, the sum ofOne Guinea

- (5) in respect of a Coroner's Certificate in Form "E" of the Schedule to the Cremation Regulations, 1957, the sum ofOne Guinea

together with :

- (a) travelling expenses actually incurred by a Deputy Coroner attending an inquest or performing any such duties as aforesaid including the cost of first class return railway fares ; or
- (b) the allowance payable in terms of the Motor Mileage Allowances Order, 1959.

Government Circular No 92/58 of 15th December, 1958 is hereby cancelled.

This determination shall have effect from 1st October, 1958.
