THE GAME ACT, 1957

THE GAME ORDER, 1961

WHEREAS the Isle of Man Forestry, Mines and Lands Board has made representations to me in terms of Section 9 of the Game Act, 1957, that a close season for pheasants and hares should be established.

NOW, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 9(1) of the Game Act, 1957, DO hereby Order as follows:—

1. From the 1st day of October, 1961, and for a term of two years thereafter the killing or taking of pheasants shall be prohibited except that between 1st day of November, 1961, and the 31st day of December, 1961, and between the 1st day of November, 1962, and the 31st day of December, 1962, the killing or taking of cock pheasants shall not be prohibited.
2. From the 1st day of October, 1961, and for a term of two years thereafter the killing or taking of hares shall be prohibited except between the 1st day of October, 1961, and the 31st day of January, 1962, and between the 1st day of October, 1962, and the 31st day of January, 1963.
3. This Order may be cited as the Game Order, 1961.
