**THE SHOP HOURS ACT, 1953 (Variation) (No. 1)**  
**ORDER, 1961.**

WHEREAS the occupiers of more than one half of the shops which retail paper backed books or novels in the respective districts of the local authorities of the Borough of Douglas and the Village District of Onchan have applied to me for an Order under Section 13 of the Shop Hours Act, 1953, to exempt retailers of paper backed books or novels from the provisions of the said Act.

AND WHEREAS I have ascertained the opinion of the persons employed in the said shops, which is that a considerable majority of such employees are in favour of the application being granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the said Lieutenant Governor by virtue of the provisions of Section 13 of the Shop Hours Act, 1953, and of all other powers me in that behalf enabling, DO hereby make the following Order :—

1. The Shop Hours Act, 1953, shall have effect as if the words “paper backed books or novels” were inserted—
  - (a) in Section 2(1) (a) after “smokers’ requisites”
  - (b) in Sections 3(1) and 3(2) (a)—as amended by the Shop Hours Amendment Act, 1956—after “magazines”
2. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours Act, 1953 (Variation) (No. 1) Order, 1961, and shall come into force on the same being approved by Tynwald.
