CREMATION ACT, 1957.

The Cremation Regulations, 1961.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by section six of the Cremation Act, 1957, DO HEREBY make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Cremation Regulations, 1961.
2. The Regulations made by the Lieutenant Governor on the 16th day of March, 1957, under the powers conferred upon him by section six of the Cremation Act, 1957, and section four of the Civil Registration and Dissenters' Marriage Act, 1933, may be cited as the Cremation Regulations, 1957.
3. In these Regulations and in the Cremation Regulations, 1957, the expressions "registered medical practitioner" and "medical practitioner" mean a person fully registered within the meaning or for the purposes of the Medical Act, 1958, or any Act amending that Act.
4. The fees which may be charged by a medical practitioner in respect of the issue of any medical certificates required under the Cremation Regulations, 1957, shall be as follows:—

For a certificate in Form B set out in the Schedule thereto	£2 2s. od.
For a certificate in Form C set out in the Schedule thereto	£2 2s. od.
For a certificate in Form D set out in the Schedule thereto	£4 4s. od.
