THE BEER (MAXIMUM WHOLESALE PRICES)
(REVOCATION) ORDER, 1961.

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by
virtue of the power vested in me by
Regulations 55 and 98 of the Defence (General)
Regulations (Isle of Man), 1939, as continued
in force by the Defence (General) Regulations
(Isle of Man) (Continuance) Order, 1960, DO
HEREBY make the following Order:

(Maximum Wholesale Prices) (Revocation) Order,
1961.
