THE POOR PRISONERS DEFENCE ACT, 1933.

THE POOR PRISONERS DEFENCE (AMENDMENT) RULES,
1961.

I, the said Deputy Governor, in
exercise of the powers conferred upon me by
Section 6 of the Poor Prisoners Defence Act,
1933 and of all other powers me in that
behalf enabling, DO hereby make the
following Rules :-

1. In paragraph (1) of Rule 4 of the
Poor Prisoners Defence Rules, 1954, as amended
by the Poor Prisoners Defence (Amendment)
Rules, 1959, the maximum fee that a
presiding Judge may fix shall be raised
from £6. 6. 0. to £12. 12. 0d.

2. These Rules may be cited as the
Poor Prisoners Defence (Amendment) Rules,
1961, and shall come into operation on the
date hereof.
