TOURIST PREMISES IMPROVEMENT ACT, 1961.

Tourist Premises Improvement Act, 1961 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961.

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 16 of the Tourist Premises Improvement Act, 1961, that the Act shall take effect on such day as the Governor may be Order appoint.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me as aforesaid DO hereby by Order appoint the first day of October, 1961, to be the appointed day for the purpose of the said Act.

This Order may be cited as the Tourist Premises Improvement Act, 1961 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961.
