INTOXICATING LIQUOR (RESTRICTIVE AGREEMENTS)
ACT, 1961.

**Intoxicating Liquor (Restrictive Agreements)
Act, 1961 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961.**

WHEREAS it is enacted by Section 4 of the Intoxicating Liquor (Restrictive Agreements) Act, 1961, that the Act shall take effect on such day as the Governor may by Order appoint.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me as aforesaid DO hereby by Order appoint the twelfth day of November, 1961, to be the appointed day for the purpose of the said Act.

This Order may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Restrictive Agreements) Act, 1961 (Appointed Day) Order, 1961.
