REGISTRATION OF DEEDS ACT, 1961.

Opening of Deeds Registry

By section six of the Registration of Deeds Act, 1961, it is enacted that the Deeds Registry shall be kept open for the despatch of all business belonging to the said office on such weekdays and during such hours as the Governor shall from time to time approve.

His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor has approved, with effect from the 13th day of November, 1961, the following times for the opening of the Deeds Registry for the despatch of public business.

Weekdays (with the exception of Bank Holidays, Easter Saturday and the second day of January in each year, except when the first day of January falls on a Sunday in which case the third day of January) from nine o'clock in the forenoon to one o'clock in the afternoon and from fifteen minutes past two o'clock in the afternoon to half past four o'clock in the afternoon except on Saturday when the hours of opening shall be between nine o'clock in the forenoon and twelve noon.

The Registration of Deeds (Closing) Regulations, 1954, made by the Governor on the first day of June, 1954, are hereby revoked.
