**Isle of Man Licensing Court of Appeal**

---

WHEREAS it is provided by subsections (1) and (2) of Section fourteen of the Licensing Act, 1961, that, for the purposes of the said Act, there shall be constituted a court of appeal, to be called the Isle of Man Licensing Court of Appeal (hereinafter referred to as "the court of appeal") which shall consist of five persons to be appointed by the Governor.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by the said Act DO hereby appoint the following persons to be members of the Court of Appeal for a term of three years computed from the 1st day of February, 1962:—

James Henry Craine, Esquire, O.B.E., J.P.

Thomas Harold Hall, Esquire, J.P.

Thomas George Henry Morris Moore, Esquire, J.P., C.P.

Ernest Henry Wood, Esquire, J.P.

AND in accordance with subsection (3) of section fourteen of the said Act, I DO hereby appoint the said John Roddam Drinkwater to be Chairman and the said James Henry Craine to be Vice-Chairman of the court of appeal.
