POLICE (ISLE OF MAN) ACT, 1962, (APPOINTED DAY)
ORDER, 1962.

WHEREAS by section 22 of the Police (Isle of Man) Act, 1962, (hereinafter called "the Act"), it is enacted that the Act shall take effect on such day as the Governor may by order appoint.

NOW, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers so conferred upon me and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf DO hereby appoint and order as follows:-

That the provisions of the said Act shall take effect on the thirteenth day of February, 1962.

This Order may be cited as the Police (Isle of Man) Act, 1962, (Appointed Day) Order, 1962.
