ISLE OF MAN CONSTITUTION ACT, 1961.

ISLE OF MAN CONSTITUTION ACT, 1961 (COMMENCEMENT)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1962.

WHEREAS by Section 27 of the Isle of Man Constitution Act, 1961 (hereinafter called "the Act"), it is enacted that the Act shall take effect on such day as the Governor may by Order appoint and different days may be appointed for different provisions of the Act.

AND WHEREAS by the Isle of Man Constitution Act, 1961 (Commencement) Order, 1961, I did appoint and order that the provisions of Part V of the Act should take effect on the 3rd day of April, 1962.

NOW THEREFORE I, the said Lieutenant Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 20 of the Interpretation Act, 1949, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf DO hereby appoint and Order as follows :-

- (1) That the Isle of Man Constitution Act, 1961 (Commencement) Order, 1961, in so far as it relates to the provisions of Part V of the Act taking effect on the 3rd day of April, 1962 be and the same is hereby revoked.
- (2) That the provisions of Part V of the Act shall take effect on the 6th day of March, 1962.
