TOURIST (ISLE OF MAN) ACT,1961.
APPEAL TRIBUNAL

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of Section 7 of the Tourist (Isle of Man) Act,1961, there is constituted an Appeal Tribunal empowered to hear and determine appeals from decisions of the Isle of Man Tourist Board relating to registration of tourist premises, and composed of (a) a Chairman who shall be a person of at least five years legal training or judicial experience, not being a practising advocate and who shall be appointed by the Governor; (b) two persons appointed by the Governor; and (c) two persons to be nominated by such body or bodies representative of persons engaging in the hotel and boarding house industry as shall be selected by the Board and whose nominations shall be approved by the Governor, or in default of such nominations, to be appointed by the Governor.

AND WHEREAS I have approved two persons nominated by the Tourist Accommodation Consultative Committee and approved by the Board.

NOW, therefore, I, the said Lieutenant Governor DO hereby appoint the following to be an Appeal Tribunal for the said purposes:-
