THE PURCHASE TAX ACT, 1949

THE PURCHASE TAX (ISLE OF MAN)(No. 1) ORDER, 1962

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by sub-section (1) of Section 37 of the Purchase Tax Act, 1949, and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, DO hereby make the following Order :-

1. The Purchase Tax (Isle of Man)(No. 1) Order, 1961, (Government Circular No. 59/61) shall be amended in accordance with the provisions of The Purchase Tax (No. 2) Order, 1961 (an Order made by Her Majesty's Treasury on the 29th November, 1961).
2. (1) This Order may be cited as the Purchase Tax (Isle of Man) (No. 1) Order, 1962.
(2) The Interpretation Act, 1949, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Tynwald.
(3) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force and to have had effect from the 8th day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty one.
