BETTING ACT 1970

LICENSED BETTING OFFICES

(HOURS OF OPENING) ORDER 1970

WHEREAS paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule to the Betting Act 1970 provides (inter alia) that Licensed Betting Offices shall be closed on weekdays except between such hours as the Governor may, with the approval of Tynwald, by Order determine.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the said Lieutenant Governor by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me as aforesaid, DO hereby order as follows:-

1. The hours during which licensed betting offices may be open on weekdays shall be from 7 o'clock in the morning to 2 o'clock in the afternoon and from 4.30 o'clock in the afternoon to 6.30 o'clock in the afternoon.
2. This Order may be cited as the Licensed Betting Offices (Hours of Opening) Order 1970.
