BETTING ACT, 1970 (APPOINTED DAY) ORDER, 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor by virtue of the powers conferred on me by section 13 (2) of the Betting Act, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:-

1. The Appointed Day for the purposes of the provisions of the Act set out in the Schedule hereto shall be the 27th day of February, 1970.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Betting Act, 1970 (Appointed Day) Order, 1970."
