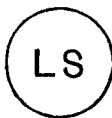


THE POLICE (ISLE OF MAN) ACT, 1962

The Isle of Man Police Cadets Pay and Allowances Determination, 1970

The Isle of Man Police Board in pursuance of Section 10(i)(c) of the Police (Isle of Man) Act, 1962, after consultation with the Governor, the Finance Board and the Isle of Man Police Federation DO hereby determine as follows :

1. As from 1st January, 1970, the rate of pay of police cadets shall be as set out at Regulation 1 of the draft Isle of Man Police Cadets (Amendment) Regulations, 1970, proposed to be made by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor (a copy of which is appended) in place of the rates set out at Schedule 1 to the Isle of Man Police Cadets Regulations, 1969, and as determined by the Isle of Man Police Board by the Isle of Man Police Cadets Pay and Allowances Determination, 1969.
2. This Determination may be cited as the Isle of Man Police Cadets Pay and Allowances Determination, 1970, and shall come into operation on the same being approved by Tynwald.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
