MOTOR MILEAGE ALLOWANCES ORDER, 1970

PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES ACT, 1957

MOTOR MILEAGE ALLOWANCES ORDER, 1970

I, the said Lieutenant Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 9 of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act, 1957, do hereby make the following Order:-

1. The allowances payable to a member of the Legislative Council, or a member of the House of Keys, or a member of a Board of Tynwald, or a member of the Executive Council, or a member of a Committee of a Board of Tynwald, or a member of a Committee of Tynwald, or a member of a Committee of the Legislative Council, or a member of a Committee of the House of Keys, or a member of the Manx Museum and National Trust, or a

member of a commission or committee appointed by the Governor, for the use of his own motor car, shall be calculated at the following rates -

	For cars up to and including 1199 c.c.	For cars exceeding 1199 c.c.
(a) for the first 5,000 miles	10d. (4.2p) per mile	1s.0d. (5p) per mile
(b) thereafter	6 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. (2.7p) per mile	8 $\frac{1}{4}$ d. (3.4p) per mile

2. The allowance shall be payable for all journeys made by the member on the business of, or on behalf of, one of the bodies specified in Article 1 hereof where the member shall certify in each case -

- (a) that the journey was necessary;
- (b) that it was made in his own vehicle, and
- (c) that it was specifically made for such purpose.

3. Fractions of a mile shall be disregarded.

4. Claims shall be submitted in the prescribed form and may be submitted to the Treasurer of the Isle of Man monthly, and shall be submitted at no longer interval than at the end of each quarter year.

5. This Order may be cited as the Motor Mileage Allowances Order, 1970, and shall operate from the 1st day of April, 1970.

6. The Motor Mileage Allowances Order, 1959, is hereby revoked.
